



Proof of Vaccination

The WA Vets has an obligation to follow the Government vaccination mandate and ensure all members are fully vaccinated or have an approved medical exemption.

There will no doubt be varying rules that apply to the many clubs that we visit. There is however a blanket rule from the Government stipulating that access to any club from 31 January 2022 will require proof of vaccination.

Therefore effective 31 January 2022, a condition for any member or guest to book and play in a WA Vets fixture, will be to provide an accepted Proof of Vaccination or a medical exemption.

Accepted Proof of Vaccination means identification for the person and one of the following showing that the person is fully vaccinated:

- a. a COVID-19 digital vaccination certificate or an Immunisation History Statement issued to the person showing the COVID-19 vaccinations recorded on the Australia Immunisation Register for the person; or
- b. a digital certificate contained in the ServiceWA app showing the COVID-19 vaccinations administered to the person; or
- c. an Immunisation History Statement issued to the person showing a medical exemption recorded on the Australian Immunisation Register for the person

provided that, in the event that the person provides proof of the kind referred to in paragraph (b), any requirement to produce identification does not apply.

Any member unable to provide any approved Proof of Vaccination will not be permitted to play in the fixture and asked to leave the premises.

Members are encouraged to voluntarily submit their Proof of Vaccination certificate to the Secretary for recording on our database. This does not remove the requirement to provide your Proof of Vaccination on the day you visit any club.
