

AVGU UPDATE TO ALL W.A. CITY AND COUNTRY VETERAN GOLFERS.

With Christmas and then the Omicron Covid outbreak in early 2022, communications to members have been quiet but the early bird registration of golfers and partners from all States and Territories for the AVGU National Championships in Mandurah has been very positive. We can safely say that we have enough registrations to proceed with the Championship organization but there is still room, and time, to accept further registrations particularly from Western Australian Vets. A common concern expressed by some members who qualify for A and B grade competitions was the challenge of playing stroke over the three days of competition. Please note that it is not mandatory to play stroke and that any individual can "retreat" into the stableford competitions following a golfing disaster! Obviously, the A and B grade Championship winner must play stroke for all three Championship days, but "dropouts" can still enjoy a daily (and overall) competition on three great golf courses. All C grade men and B grade women will play a stableford competition for the Championship so this information does not apply to them.

Members who have registered as players and who would like to play The Cut Golf Course on the Wednesday of the Championship week are informed that this is, at \$60, a popular option and there are only 4 places left. This is a special deal organized by the Championship Committee and you can register to play by including it in the registration process and paying the \$60 fee.
