It was agreed that the drinks be on a "consumption basis" with a maximum of \$15 per head. Spirits to be available on a Cash basis.

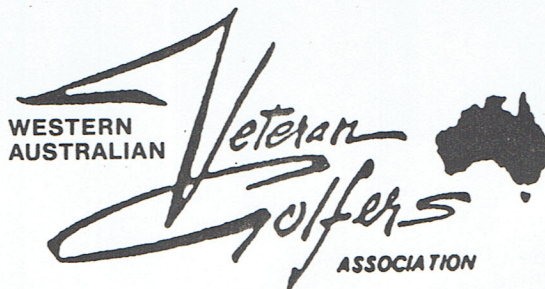

Ross Sheen advised that the Dinner at Observation City had been finalised, with Dance Floor and extra tables for Trophies.

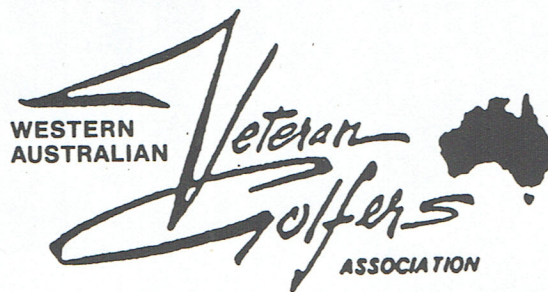


