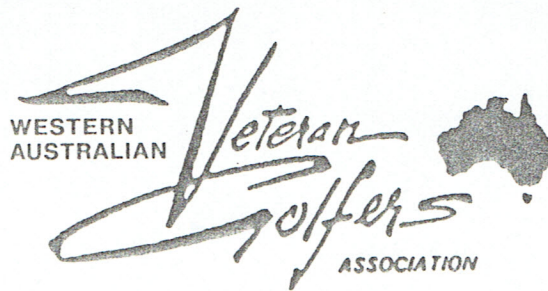

Practically all Golf Clubs have now advised us that they would be delighted to accept our offer of providing a Trophy for the 91/92 Season.





It was agreed that the Committee arranging the purchase of trophy's for 92, meet at an early date.


