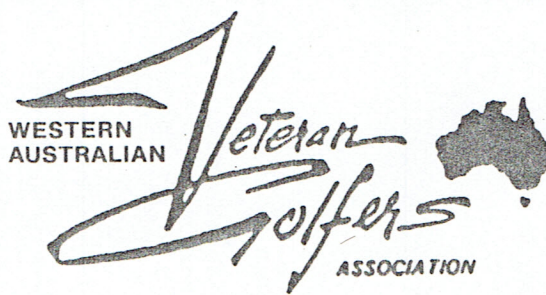

It was agreed that a letter be sent to all Members whose Subscriptions were overdue.

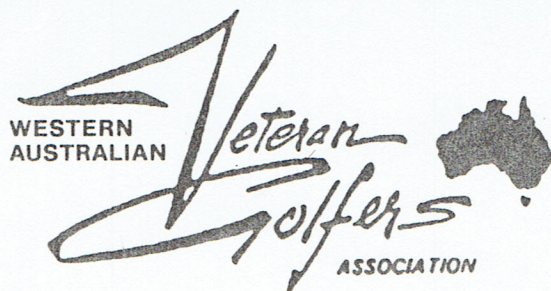

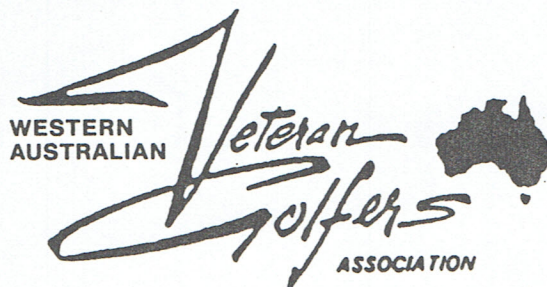
It was advised that both Merv Hawthorne and Brian Bolton were well on the way to recovery, and we wish them both a speedy return to our golfing days.


It was agreed that as soon as our 1993 Programme is printed, it will, together with a Bulletin, be mailed to all Members.
