drinks. No problem with accomodation however would be more  
expensive than Mandurah.

The Secretary would seek finer details from the Vines to have a  
fair comparison with the presentation from Mandurah.

The Secretary had been in touch with various Departments re  
Sponsorship/ Grant etc. however would now seek a general meeting  
with Ray Turner (President W.A. Golf Union) for some help. Also  
would check out with Tourist Bureau.

In summary both venues had their good points however following  
the game at the Vines on 28/7/03 we should be in a good position  
to better review the two options Mandurah v The Vines. on 5/8/03.

Re NSW Vets / AVGA affiliation fees. The Secretary had received further information however the situation had not been resolved. AVGU Special Meeting by phone Resolved to endorse Secretary action to agreeing to reduce all states fees from 20c back to 15.6c to match NSW. Who will pay \$2000 (15.6), refunds (4.4c) will be given to the other states. This will save NSW from being expelled from the AVGU and their members allowed to play at National in Tasmania.
