- (4) The presentation dinner to be in one room ( if this can't be done then look at curtailing the entries ) we may be forced to have a cut off in numbers eventually.
- (5) The AVGU should be the one to present the winners with the Trophies.
- (6) Recognition of Winners and Runner ups in all grades at presentations.
- (7) As this is a AVGU Tournament the "Symbol of Fellowship" should be presented by the President to the next host state Delegate or Tournament Director, for safe keeping.
