If an emergency or any urgent circumstances arise after 6pm Sunday before any fixture, text the Captain and inform the fixture club especially if you have booked a cart. Always remember we are guests at our host clubs and it is important that we strive to maintain a positive relationship to ensure the Vets are always welcomed at any golf club.
